




- Eligibility List Process Steps
- Orientation: Attendance is mandatory
- Written Examination (40% Weighting)
 - Test will be conducted on-line. A raw score of 70 or higher is required in order to be selected for the...
- Oral Interview: (60% Weighting)- Pending successful completion of step 1 &2.
- Initial Posting: Posted inside the Police Department and on the web page. Results are in rank order.
 - Candidates have 10 days from the date of the Initial Posting to submit a request in writing to the Manteno Police Commission requesting the addition of preference points
- Preference Point Qualifications (Illinois State Statute: 65 ILCS 5)- 5 points
- <u>Veteran preference</u>: Persons who were engaged in the military service of the United States for a period of at least one year of active duty and who were honorably discharged therefrom, or who are now or have been members on inactive or reserve duty in such military or naval service
- <u>Educational preference</u>: Persons who have successfully obtained an associate's degree in the field of Law enforcement, or a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. Degree should be achieved by the start of testing process.
- <u>Certified</u>: Successful completion of the Minimum Standards Basic Law Enforcement Training Course as provided in the Illinois Police Training Act and are currently serving as a law enforcement officer on a part-time or full-time basis within the State of Illinois
- Final Posting: Once scores are re-tabulated with the addition of Preference Points; the final list is posted. Final results are in rank order.
- Note: From the Final List, qualified candidates may receive a conditional offer of employment and participate in additional post-offer screenings and examinations including but not limited to: polygraph examination; psychological evaluation; character and background investigation and credit check; medical examinations and drug screening.
- Lateral Hire List Process Steps
- Orientation: Attendance is mandatory
- Oral Interview
- Final Posting: Results are in rank order.
- Note: From the Final List, qualified candidates may receive a conditional offer of employment and participate in additional post-offer screenings and examinations including but not limited to: polygraph examination; psychological evaluation; character and background investigation and credit check; medical examinations and drug screening.
