

# APPLICATION FOR LOCAL VIDEO GAMING LICENSE and VIDEO GAMING TERMINAL PERMIT STICKERS

#### **DEFINITIONS**

**Licensed Establishment:** any establishment that is both licensed to sell liquor at retail in the Village under 4-1-6-12 of the Village Code and licensed by the Illinois Gaming Board to operate a video gaming terminal on its premises.

**Video Gaming Terminal (VGT):** any electronic video game machine that, upon insertion of cash, is available to play or simulate the play of a video game, including but not limited to video poker, line up, and blackjack, utilizing a video display and microprocessors in which the player may receive free games or credits that can be redeemed for cash. The term does not include a machine that directly dispenses coins, cash, or tokens or is for amusement purposes only.

### **LOCAL REGULATIONS:**

- 1. A valid Village video gaming terminal permit sticker shall be clearly displayed at all times on each video gaming terminal.
- 2. No more than Illinois State Statue allows of gaming terminals may be located on the licenses establishment's premises.
- 3. All video gaming terminals must be located in an area restricted to persons twenty-one (21) years of age or older. The entrance to such area must, at all times, be within the view of at least one (1) employee who is a least twenty-one (21) years of age.
- 4. No licensed establishment may cause or permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to use, play or operate a video gaming terminal.
- 5. No video gaming terminal may be played except during the legal hours of operation allowed for the consumption of alcoholic beverages at the licensed establishment pursuant to Title 3, Chapter 9 of the Village Code.
- 6. The licensed establishment must fully comply with the Illinois Video Gaming Act (230 ILCS 40/1, et seq.) and all rules, regulations and restrictions imposed by the Illinois Gaming Board.
- 7. The licensed establishment must fully comply with Title 4-1-6-12 of the Village Code and all other provisions of the Village Code as well as federal and Illinois law and regulations.

## ANNUAL FEES (Fiscal Year 5/1 – 4/30) Village Code 4-1-6-12(D)

\$100.00 - Video Gaming License, due upon application submittal for each Licensed Establishment.

\$250.00 - Video Gaming Terminal Permit Sticker Fee, this fee is per video gaming terminal.
