Items for Discussion:

- **Significant Case Updates** – Chief Swinford stated the department has received complaints that two of the village’s liquor establishments have been serving underage drinkers. The Illinois State Police will be going to these businesses to do a detail to check if they serve underage persons. More walk throughs will be completed by the department.

There was damage done to the new Legacy Park Concession Stand bathrooms. Offenders have been identified. Pictures of the offenders were placed on the department’s Facebook page. This helped identify the offenders. An invoice for reimbursement of costs of the damage will be given to the offenders.

- **Monthly Stats** – Chief Swinford presented the monthly stats for December 2022 and also for the 2022 year.
- **Personnel Update** – The Police Commission will begin the process for new hires soon. Officer Schubert is still in the FTO process and is doing well.
- **PD Facility Update** – Village personnel met with contractor to answer various questions. Framing is approximately two-thirds completed.
- **Damage/Vandalism Recap** - Chief Swinford presented a spreadsheet showing list of for 2022.

Chief Swinford announced that State’s Attorney Jim Rowe in partnership with our department and the Illinois Veteran’s Home will be hosting a mobile Senior Safety Fair on May 10th at the Manteno Veteran’s Home.
