- Salt Usage (Hanley)
 - O Used about 70-90 tons to date
 - o Requests for extra salt

 - We have salted all roads during extremely icy conditions
- Legacy Park Disc Golf Course (Hanley)
 - o 3-Hole--\$6000
 - o 6- hole \$9500 in design and equipment
 - Jim Hanley is to contact Manteno township and set up a meeting with the Disc golf designer

WPCC

- Sand Filter
 - Table this subject until next month

- Water Tank
 - Table this subject until next month
- Manhole Inspection/smoke testing (Aggen)
 - Both of these projects have been completed and the next step would be to clean and video the sewer mains. The public works department will address some of the easily accessible repairs and compile a list of the repairs we would like to take place. No action on this subject.
- o **GIS** (Hanley & Aggen)
 - Robinson Engineering is to provide the GIS software service to the village and will have a proposal ready for the next board meeting.

The mayor requested a list of all the near future project costs for WPCC.

• Second Street Project (Aggen)

- A meeting is scheduled for next month between Robinson, Hitchcock and the Village
- The design is getting the topo details for accuracy.
- o Scheduled start date for the project is April 1, 2017.

• **2017 Projects** (*Hanley*)

- o Swale re-grading waiting on permits from DNR and IEPA.
- o Theis Park Replacement will keep project in mind for the 2017-2018 budget.
- o Rock Creek Park will keep project in mind for the 2017-2018 budget.
- o Adding outlets on the Main Street berm
 - Mayor Nugent stated that this would be needed if the trees on the berm were lighted. Public Works has looked into the potential – could use the existing light poles
- o Trustee Martin would like to see more "Mommy and Me" swings in other parks
- o Heritage Park is the next park in line for rubber mulch
