## **Items for Discussion:**

- **Personnel Updates** – The next Police Pension Board meeting is scheduled for July 18<sup>th</sup>. A final approval on Mr. Rebus's duty disability claim is on the agenda. Mr. Rebus has exhausted all benefit time.
- **Lateral Entry** - The top lateral entry candidate, Scott Halper, has completed all of the required steps. Mr. Halper will be offered a position. Mr. Halper is familiar with the village and computer system as he is a current City of Kankakee officer. Mr. Halper also already lives in the village. Mr. Halper will replace the

opening created by Ptlm. Tobeck as the School Resource Officer. Once Mr. Rebus's situation is finalized, the village will evaluate the department about adding another officer.

- **SRO Update** – Ptlm. Tobeck has been appointed as the new SRO. Ptlm. Tobeck was the only officer who submitted his application. The school approved his appointment and has started meeting together to work on all the details and expectations.
- **Golf Cart Registration** – Over 80% have updated their registrations. There have been no citations issued. A suggestion for having a multi-year registration was given. Chief Swinford will research the idea.
