Items for Discussion:

- **Significant Case Updates –**
 - Three Car Burglaries at Legacy Park – car was identified, but cameras did not get a clear picture of person responsible of breaking the windows and taking items. Perry Farm in Bradley was also hit with same vehicle. An extra camera has been installed to provide closer and clearer pictures of people.
 - Scam – Victim received email about instructions for down payment of property. Email was a scam, and the money was sent to a wrong account. FBI was called.

- **Personnel Update –**
 - Two officers have recently had newborns and are off
 - One officer is out on military leave
 - Lt. Lockwood will be retiring on July 20th
 - New lateral officer has been hired and started but cannot work on the street yet until the state gives him his certification. He will be required to take a four-day transition course and four-hour firearm transition course.
