Mr. Venhusizen asked who is responsible for maintenance of the pond. Mr. Hanley stated that the pond is the responsibility of Oak Ridge. He has spoken several times with management concerning the pond. Mr. Hanley stated that he understood that the park management has worked with pest control companies to trap beavers and also an excavator to clear the drain. Mr. Hanley will communicate with the park management.

• **250 S. Elm Street** – Mr. Marion has been working on the property for several years. Liens have been placed on the property for mowing and debris clean-up. The village attorney
