PC-VAR 25-01: Consideration of a request by Gotion, Inc., Owner, and Olympic Signs, Petitioner, for a Sign Variance from Ordinance 9-13-15; 9-13-14D(1), D(2), and D(4) to allow two premises signs, increased size and increased height, on the building at 333 Spruce Street, in the I-2 Heavy Industrial Zoning District.

Robbie from Olympic sign company speaking at 6:08 about installing two signs. The east side would be internally illuminated they have LED's inside the ability you could dim them they're not super bright standard channel letter signage. A question from George Reichardt how big are these signs going to be? The answer is 84 sq ft. on the north elevation 64 sq ft. on the east elevation. The Gotion building is 40 feet tall. Paul Motel then asked about the LED and how many strips would be installed? Robbie replied with he would have to get back with the answer to that. Motel asked, you did mention they were dimmable if in the event that the LED driver does malfunction, Motel had another question pertaining to how many were there is there going to be one LED driver per trip of lights or is that per sign? Robbie replies with," per sign One driver per sign and that would be accessible so if the driver failed the actual whole sign would go out and we have a full service department to take care of the driver." Motel then asks," so in the event of the driver failing it wouldn't create any type of flashing like a ballast wood with fluorescent lights? Robbie's reply, is No that would shut the Gotion sign down."

<u>PC-SUP 25-01</u> A public hearing is being held to consider a request by Dominick Cappelletti, Petitioner, and Russ Jensen, Owner, for a Special Use Permit per Ordinance 9-10C-3-2(B) to allow vehicle rentals, specifically, U-Haul trucks & trailers on their property at 707 N.
