

ORDINANCE NO. 25-34

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, BUSINESS REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 9, LIQUOR, SECTION 3-9-4, FEE, AND SECTION 3-9-14, LIMITATION, AND BY AMENDING TITLE 4, POLICE REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 1, MISDEMEANOR CODE, ARTICLE 6, OFFENSES INVOLVING MORALITY, SECTION 4-1-6-12, GAMBLING, OF THE VILLAGE OF MANTENO MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Manteno, as follows:

Section 1

That Title 3, Business Regulations, Chapter 9, Liquor, of the Manteno Municipal Code, be amended by changing Section 3-9-4, Fee, to read as follows:

3-9-4: FEE:

Retail licenses for the sale of alcoholic liquor shall be divided into the following classes for which the following fees shall be paid:

...

(J) Class NVG (No Video Gaming) license shall authorize the retail sale on the premises specified of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises, only, and only when there is no video gaming terminal, as defined in Section 5 of the Video Gaming Act, 230 ILCS 40/5, present on said premises. Class NVG licensee shall permit, keep, possess, own, use, or permit the operation or playing of, a video gaming terminal on any Class NG premises. The annual fee for such license shall be one thousand one hundred twenty five dollars (\$1,125.00).

Section 2

That Title 3, Business Regulations, Chapter 9, Liquor, of the Manteno Municipal Code, be amended by changing Section 3-9-14, Limitation, to read as follows:

3-9-14: LIMITATION:

(a) There shall not hereafter be issued within the corporate limits of the village more than eight (8) class A licenses; nine (9) class B licenses; two (2) class C licenses; two (2) class D licenses; zero (0) class E licenses; zero (0) Class F licenses; zero (0) Class SE-

NP licenses; zero (0) class SE-FP licenses; and one (1) Class NVG license. The number of Class O licenses shall be limited by the underlying class of licenses they supplement.

Section 3

That Title 4, Police Regulations, Chapter 1, Misdemeanor Code, Article 6, Offenses Involving Morality, of the Manteno Municipal Code, be amended by changing Section 4-1-6-12, Gambling, to read as follows:

4-1-6-12: GAMBLING:

(A) Definitions. The following words, terms, phrases and their derivations, when used in this section, shall have the meanings ascribed herein, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

...

LICENSED ESTABLISHMENT means any licensed retail establishment where alcoholic liquor is drawn, poured, mixed, or otherwise served for consumption on the premises, whether the establishment operates on a nonprofit or for-profit basis, but excluding a Class NVG licensed retail establishment. "Licensed establishment" includes any such establishment that has a contractual relationship with an inter-track wagering location licensee licensed under the Illinois Horse Racing Act of 1975, provided any contractual relationship shall not include any transfer or offer of revenue from the operation of video gaming under this Act to any licensee licensed under the Illinois Horse Racing Act of 1975. Provided, however, that the licensed establishment that has such a contractual relationship with an inter-track wagering location licensee may not, itself, be (i) an inter-track wagering location licensee, (ii) the corporate parent or subsidiary of any licensee licensed under the Illinois Horse Racing Act of 1975, or (iii) the corporate subsidiary of a corporation that is also the corporate parent or subsidiary of any licensee licensed under the Illinois Horse Racing Act of 1975. "Licensed establishment" does not include a facility operated by an organization licensee, an inter-track wagering licensee, or an inter-track wagering location licensee licensed under the Illinois Horse Racing Act of 1975 or a riverboat licensed under the Illinois Gambling Act, except as provided in this paragraph.

Section 4

If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

Section 6

This ordinance shall be immediately in full force and effect after the passage, approval as provided by law.


