MOTION: Public works & Utilities Motion of approval for meeting minutes from February 24th, 2026 Motion by Trustee Boudreau second by Trustee Gesky approved by all. Mayor LaMore absent Trustee Barry and Trustee Zimbelman absent

Discussion Items:

- **Heritage Park Soccer Shed update-** Hanley provided pictures in the handout of the layout of soccer shed to be started this week. Update that masonry buildings were taken down, fence structure is ordered will be up before the baseball season starts. Matching the other two buildings with the siding and the shingles. Hanley is going to get prices on metal roof versus shingles.
- **Pavilion update-** Hanley provided print out of update, getting the peers ready to pour and plumber starts today. The electrician waiting till the plumbing in the ground first. water connection over in south side by playground area that houses a RPZ looking to eliminate that and put the RPZ in the building. The water fountain not working, it worked one year and has not worked since bad pipe tried replacing. Proposing placing a mounted water fountain on the pavilion. The kit is set to arrive today. If all goes as planned completion should be done within the next two months.

- **MFT list / Project Selection-** Bruce Hill handed out a preliminary estimate of cost resurfacing/ patching. Hill gave Chris a design agreement that Mayor LaMore can sign once done April 24th would be bid opening and an award on the first meeting of May.
- **Path list / Project Selection-** Hanley provided print out on last two pages of pamphlet. From Winfield Playground to Eagles Landing playground approximately 5000 feet the second location is from 10000 on Maple St and north of Water Tower Road heading West over to Willow approximately 3500 feet. 50,000 is set aside for path maintenance. Maple path will be first, wait on Eagle's landing till the pond issue is resolved. Hanley will get quotes on a few benches for along the walking path.
- **Storm Sewer Project Updates-** Bruce Hill gave update. Leahy Area project Hydro seeding got done last week. Allied handling supplemental watering. Asphalt patching to be done when the asphalt plant opens, expected soon. Heritage Park- Lavicka to be on site in next two weeks to finish restoration.
- **Public Works Equipment-** Hanley looking to replace 2008 international plow truck. Hanley looked into getting work done on it currently it needs a new transmission the housing is cracked. Mechanic suggested to get rid of the truck. Trade in value could be under 20,000. Trustee Gesky asked about leasing. Hanley will look into leasing. To be brought back up at the next board meeting for more discussion.
