BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

1. That the proposed improvement shall consist of resurfacing South Spruce Street in the Village of Manteno including hot-mix asphalt surface removal, hot-mix asphalt resurfacing, pavement patching, concrete curb and gutter removal and replacement, sidewalk removal & replacement, and all incidental and collateral work.

2. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of Eighty thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$80,000.00) for the improvement of said section from the Local Public Agency's allotment of Motor Fuel Tax funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk is hereby directed to transmit four (4) certified originals of this resolution to the district office of the Department of Transportation.
