• I-57 Cameras – The cameras are operational. Chief Swinford gave a brief demonstration with the live data. The search capabilities were also previewed. The data is stored for 90 days. Extra cameras could be installed to look east and west on Division Street.

It was suggested that a program be developed that could be offered to businesses to update their security cameras where the village would split the cost and then allow access by the police to the cameras if needed.

The software allows the police to also view the Main Street plaza cameras.

• School Resource Officer – Chief Swinford met with the finance committee of the School District and then with the full board. Questions were answered and the proposal was approved at the School Board meeting. This will be a 50/50 split for all costs. The officer will have an office in the high school, but will be going to all school buildings. This is a three (3) year commitment.
